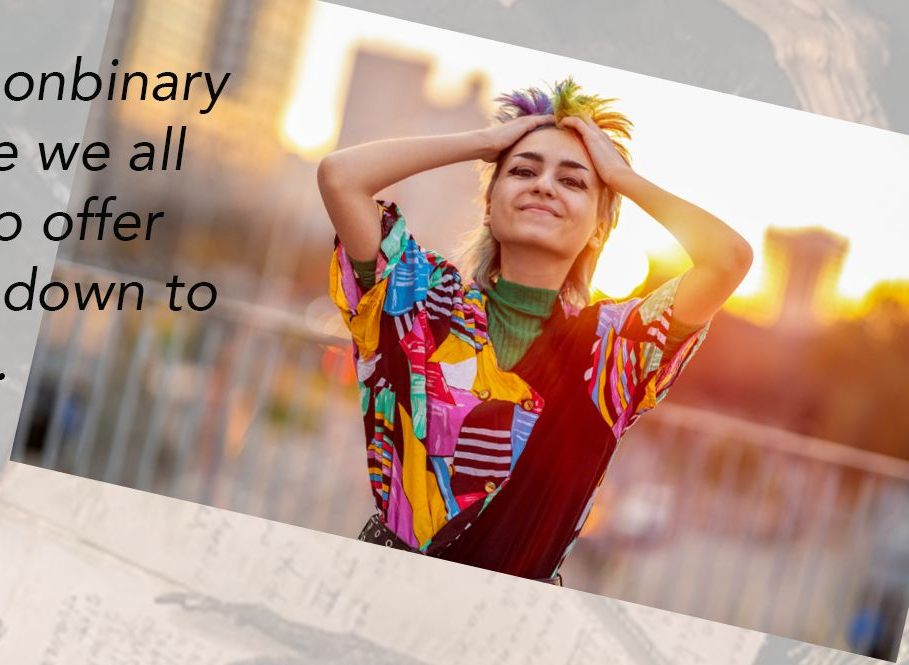


Alex

Style:

Jaime Jessup - Creator

Jaime graduated from the University of Central Florida's Film School and began her Feature writing career with Caius Productions' KARAOKE KING which appeared on Netflix and won the Skyline Indie Festival in 2014. She also wrote THE MARC MERO PROJECT for Caius Productions, and Peterbuilt's WHEELER, optioned by Suzanne DeLaurentiis. After relocating to NYC and then Los Angeles, Jaime cut her TV-writing teeth interning at SESAME STREET (PBS), and THE WALKING DEAD (VMP) then assisting in the Writer's Departments at CSI: MIAMI (CBS). Jaime's blogs have won two LOL "Life Out Loud" Literary Competitions, and she has spoken on a panel at DragonCon with Renegade Films after serving as a Script Supervisor on Tom Savini's WEB OF DARKNESS. She's written live shows for Sea World Orlando, as well. Most recently, Jaime sold a pilot to OFTV's streaming services and has a feature-length horror film, HIDE, currently in development with Nightfox Studios.

Having miraculously survived in Los Angeles earning a living as a live performer, professional blogger and screenwriter for-hire, Jaime is known for her quick turn-around time and a passion for all things spooky, kooky and quirky.



Curtis Andersen - Producer

Curtis Andersen began his professional entertainment career in 1985 as the voice of Schroeder from the Peanuts series. He spent over three decades in front of the camera on shows like Party of Five, 3rd Rock From the Sun, That 70's Show, Malcolm in the Middle, Veronica Mars, The Gilmore Girls, and Feud: Bette & Joan. He has recurred on Saved by the Bell: The New Class, 7th Heaven, and played Gordie on Sabrina the Teenage Witch. In addition to his television work, Curtis has also been seen in the films The Rules of Attraction, Mary-Kate & Ashley Olsen's Winning London, and the Oscar award winning Pearl Harbor among others.

In 2005 he founded his first production company and created and sold a series of genre projects including the horror film Stupid Teenagers Must Die!, reality television series Enter the Wolf for Syfy, and helped found the Fun Size Horror anthology series seen on Hulu. In addition, Curtis has produced several award-winning short films, live events, stage shows, and the Alter Nation animated web series in support of the toy line from Panda Mony Toy Brands.
