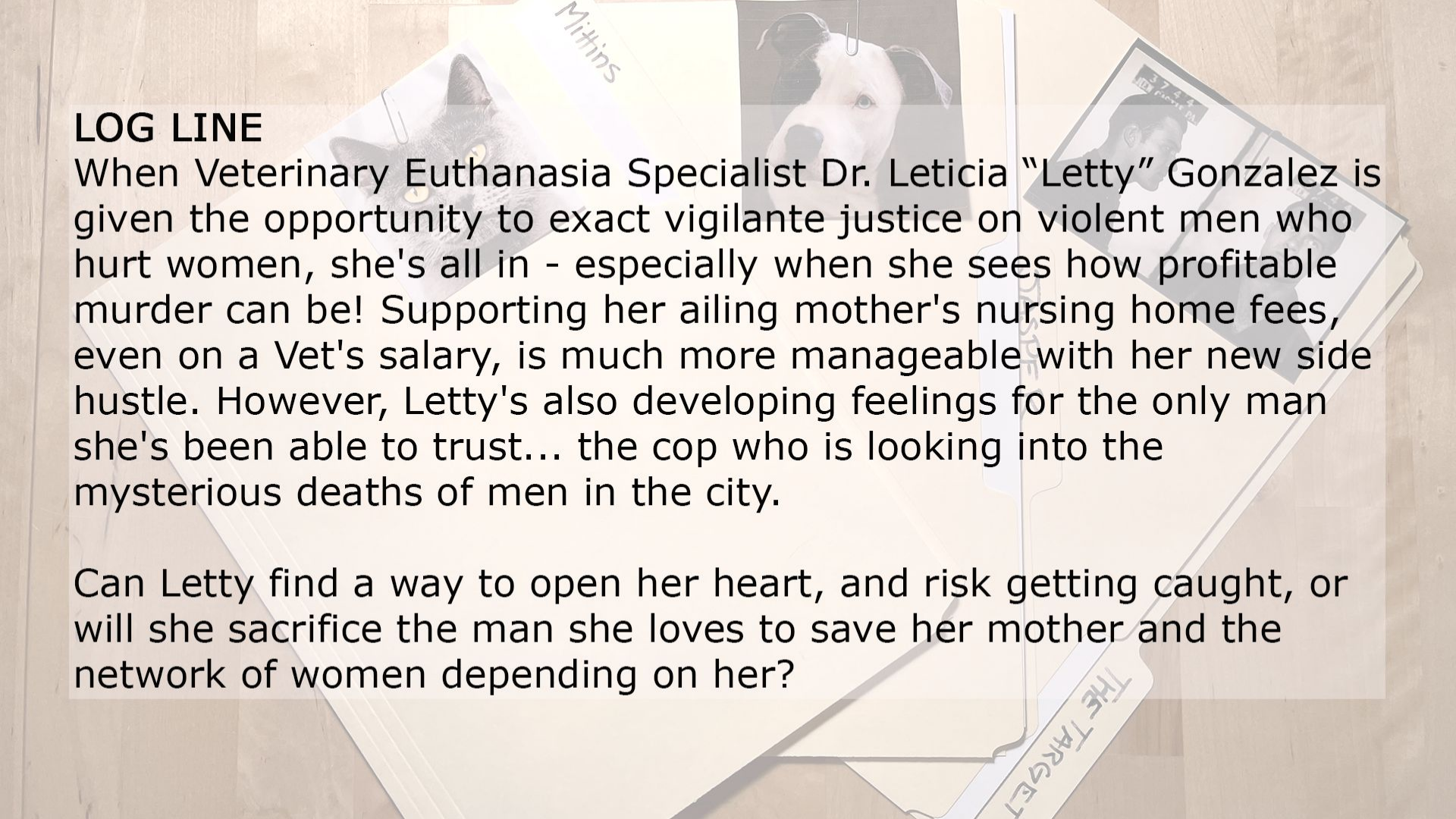

However, Letty's also developing feelings for the only man she's been able to trust... the cop who is looking into the mysterious deaths of men in the city.

Can Letty find a way to open her heart, and risk getting caught, or will she sacrifice the man she loves to save her mother and the network of women depending on her?

SYNOPSIS

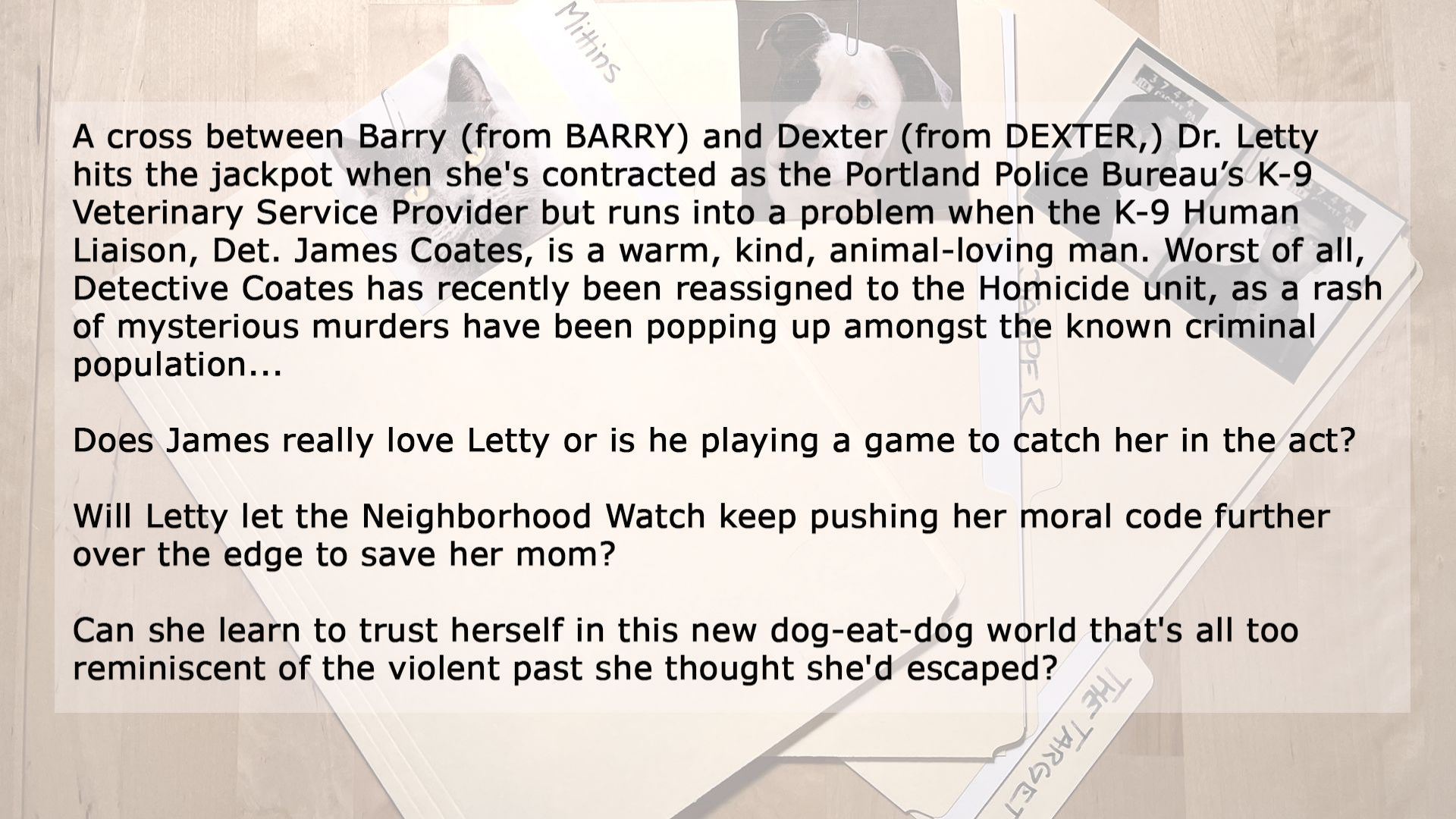
Rainbow Bridge follows Dr. Leticia Herrera, who, with her mother, escaped a violent past as the daughter of a Cartel leader. Letty and her mother immigrate to Portland, and Letty becomes a Veterinarian In-Home Pet Euthanasia Specialist because she is more comfortable with animals and death than people, and life. While assisting a dying pit bull at the home of a woman clearly being abused, Dr. Letty follows the abuser to a bar and secretly squirts her heart-stopping chemical cocktail into his drink.

The bewildered wife storms into Letty's office the next morning, demanding to know if Letty's killed her husband.

"Because if you did... I have more for you."

This is Letty's introduction to a secret underground network called "The Neighborhood Watch," a group of women who know where to find and how to get to every abusive, evil man in the Pacific Northwest. From garden-variety cheaters to neo-Nazis, these ladies have ALL the tea. And their tea is poison.

The Watch will pay Letty to take out all the bad dogs, and the new side hustle is particularly tempting because Letty's mother must live in a Memory Care Facility, and the expenses are mounting.



A cross between Barry (from BARRY) and Dexter (from DEXTER,) Dr. Letty hits the jackpot when she's contracted as the Portland Police Bureau's K-9 Veterinary Service Provider but runs into a problem when the K-9 Human Liaison, Det. James Coates, is a warm, kind, animal-loving man. Worst of all, Detective Coates has recently been reassigned to the Homicide unit, as a rash of mysterious murders have been popping up amongst the known criminal population...

Does James really love Letty or is he playing a game to catch her in the act?

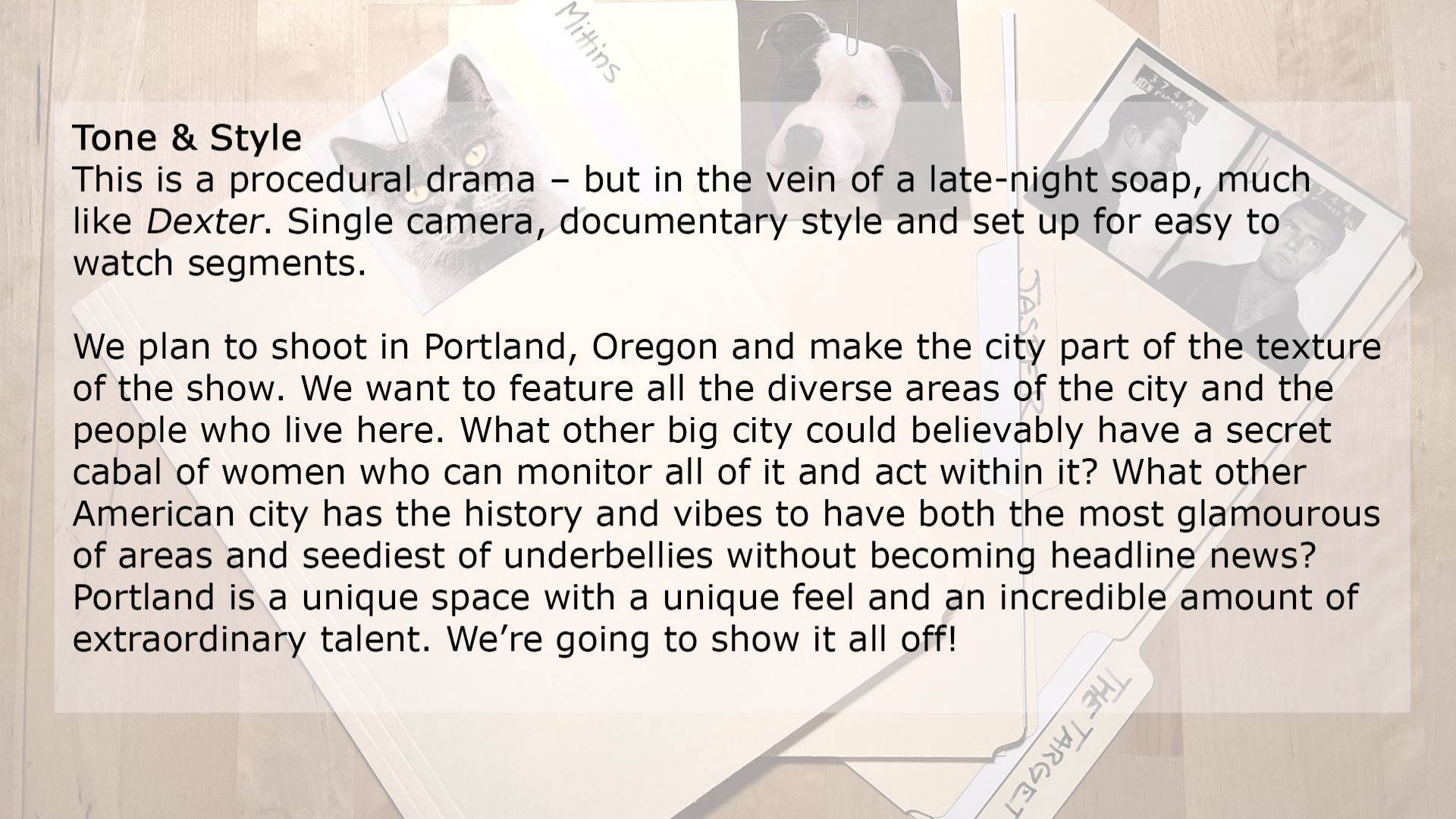
Will Letty let the Neighborhood Watch keep pushing her moral code further over the edge to save her mom?

Can she learn to trust herself in this new dog-eat-dog world that's all too reminiscent of the violent past she thought she'd escaped?

Themes

Justice. Morality. Abuse. All three weigh heavily on the minds of people in the United States right now. For many there is a feeling of helplessness and desire for someone to do something – anything – to help.

The show also explores how far we will go to gaslight ourselves when we are faced with the fact that we may be choosing something for the wrong reasons, especially when we think we are doing “good”.

Tone & Style

This is a procedural drama – but in the vein of a late-night soap, much like *Dexter*. Single camera, documentary style and set up for easy to watch segments.

We plan to shoot in Portland, Oregon and make the city part of the texture of the show. We want to feature all the diverse areas of the city and the people who live here. What other big city could believably have a secret cabal of women who can monitor all of it and act within it? What other American city has the history and vibes to have both the most glamorous of areas and seediest of underbellies without becoming headline news? Portland is a unique space with a unique feel and an incredible amount of extraordinary talent. We're going to show it all off!

Regular Cast

Dr. Leticia Herrera ("Letty") - 30's - Letty spent her early childhood in Juarez in the 90's, but when the family pit bull intervenes to save her mother from her father's violence, Letty develops a deep love for animals. And a serious disdain for most people - especially men. Letty and her mother seek asylum from the cartel and immigrate to Portland, where Letty becomes a Veterinarian and then an In-Home Euthanasia Specialist. She leads a spartan, solitary life, working hard to provide for her mother's health care.

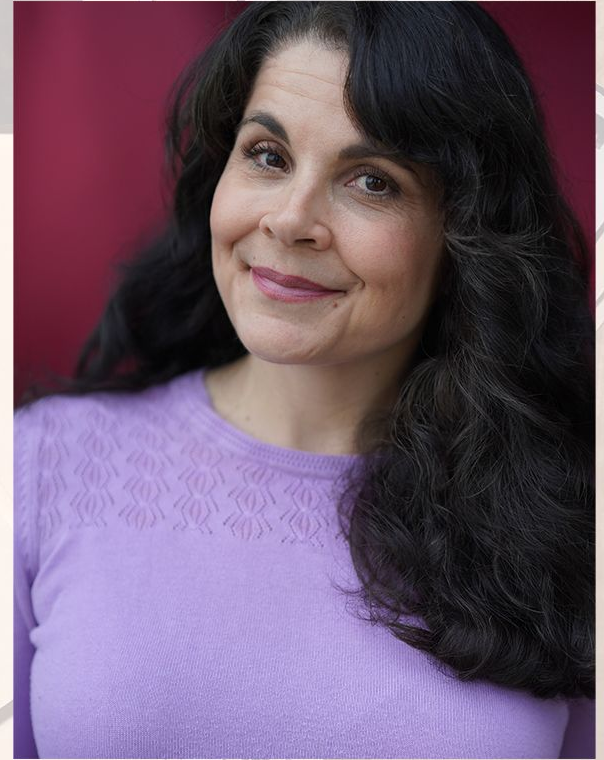


Carrie - late 20's - bubbly bright receptionist in Dr. Letty's office, and the counterbalance to Letty's gloom. Carrie was begrudgingly hired by Dr. Letty in the same way we begrudgingly get a flu shot: Carrie is the medicine Letty needs when things get too dark.

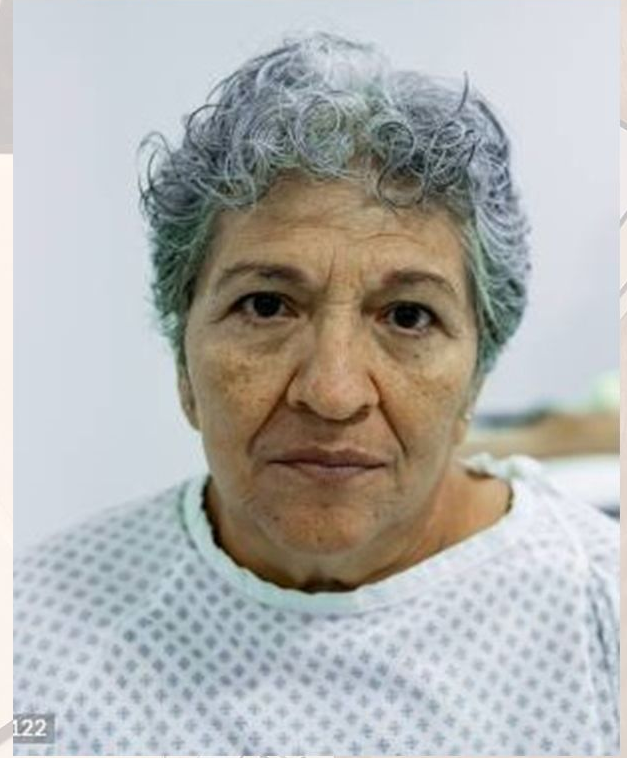
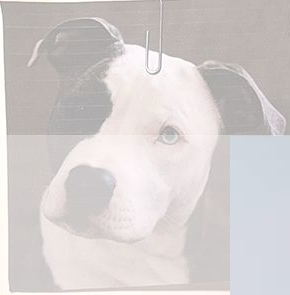
Carrie's the kind of friend who not only knows your Starbucks order but instinctively knows when you NEED it.



Maria - 30's - Maria hires Dr. Letty to perform in-home Euthanasia for her beloved dog, Dodger. When things take a turn and Maria's husband winds up dead, Maria has some important questions for Letty...



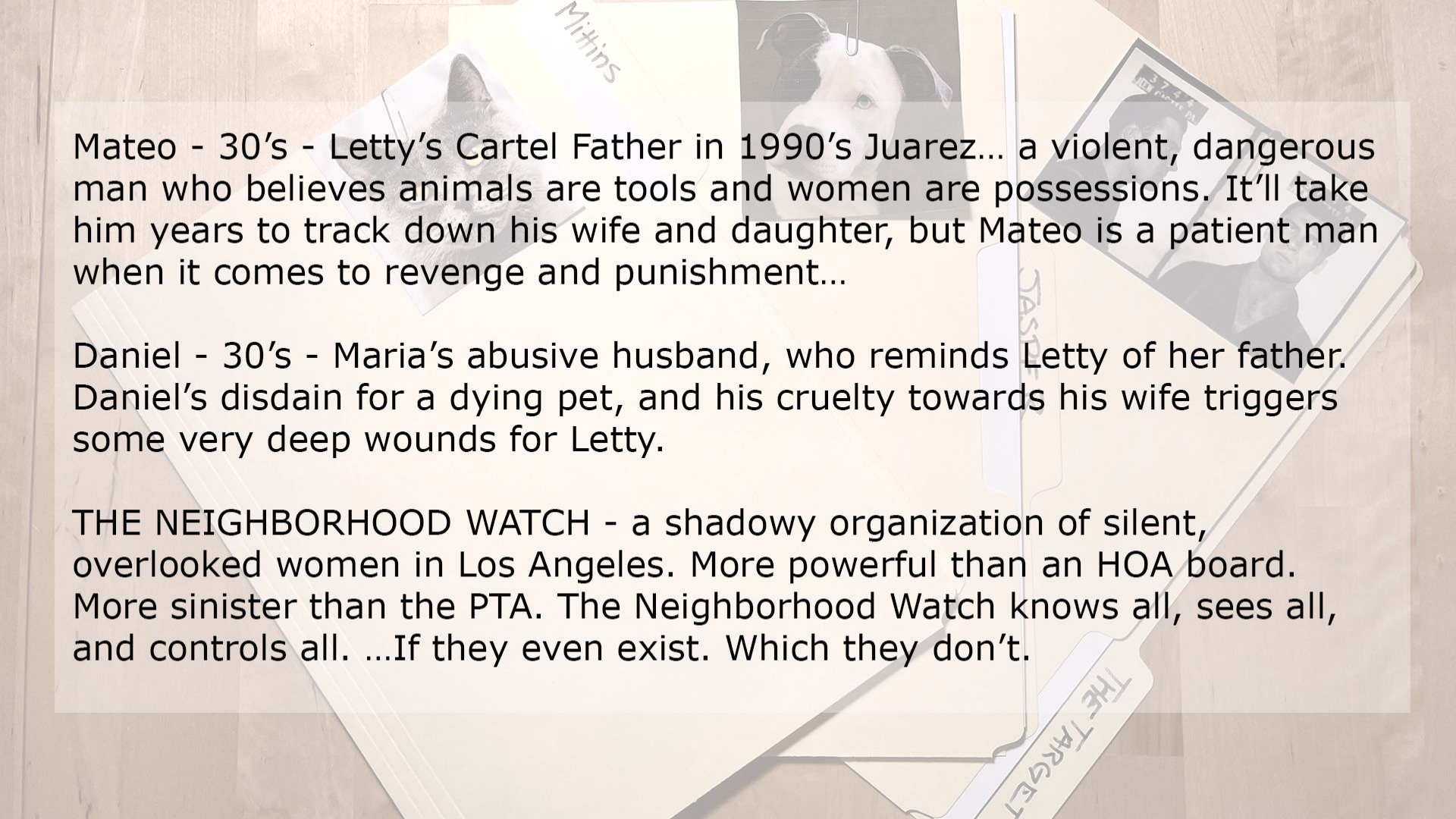
Veronica - 60's - Letty's mom, deeply proud of her accomplished daughter. Veronica was a badass back in the day but Early Onset Dementia has placed her in a Nursing Home, where she needs round-the-clock care that Letty just can't give her. Veronica risked everything to escape Cartel life and immigrate with Letty to Los Angeles. She bears the scars of her violent past on her face. Slowly losing her memory is upsetting to Letty but may be a blessing for Veronica.



THE TARGET

Officer James Coates - 40's - James oversees the PPB's K-9 Officer Division, and reaches out to Dr. Letty to ask if she'll serve as an advisor for a panel devoted to caring for retired K-9's. The more they consult, the more they discover that they have in common, and an unexpected friendship blooms between the two. Funny and warm, James is Letty's opposite - and he might just be the first man Letty feels she can trust.





Mateo - 30's - Letty's Cartel Father in 1990's Juarez... a violent, dangerous man who believes animals are tools and women are possessions. It'll take him years to track down his wife and daughter, but Mateo is a patient man when it comes to revenge and punishment...

Daniel - 30's - Maria's abusive husband, who reminds Letty of her father. Daniel's disdain for a dying pet, and his cruelty towards his wife triggers some very deep wounds for Letty.

THE NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH - a shadowy organization of silent, overlooked women in Los Angeles. More powerful than an HOA board. More sinister than the PTA. The Neighborhood Watch knows all, sees all, and controls all. ...If they even exist. Which they don't.
